Facebook removed Onavo—a free VPN run by the social networking company—from the iOS App Store today. The voluntary move by Facebook was prompted by discussions with Apple about privacy policy. Onavo promises to help “secure your personal details” on the product’s website, but the VPN service exists primarily so Facebook can monitor user activity on rival sites. In other words, Facebook uses it to spy on you. Onavo is installed on around 33 million devices. As of this writing, Onavo is no longer available for new downloads on the App Store, but existing users still have the current version on their devices. We suggest uninstalling it now. Here’s a statement from Apple about the removal, via Juli Clover at MacRumors: With the latest update to our guidelines, we made it explicitly clear that apps should not collect information about which other apps are installed on a user’s device for the purposes of analytics or advertising/marketing and must make it clear what user data will be collected and how it will be used. Onavo remains available on Android’s Google Play store, but we suggest anyone using it uninstall now and find a VPN that respects your privacy. Sometimes offices, colleges and other establishments (even countries!) block gaming, and occasionally individual players are banned. While many player bans are perfectly justified, some players feel Fortnite’s T&Cs are too strict.Is there a way around these issues to unblock Fortnite? Yes, but it can be tricky. One of the simplest ways to evade a block is to use a Virtual Private Network, or VPN for short. Provided you have admin access on your device to install it, a VPN creates a secure tunnel between you and the servers - in this case, the Fortnite ones - that enables you to bypass many kinds of blocks such as IP banning, which prevents specified internet addresses from connecting or being connected to. Unfortunately Fortnite also has a no-VPN policy, so not every VPN service works. Our current working favourite is ExpressVPN (opens in new tab), but there are others worth considering too. Let’s find out more.How to unblock FortniteAll you need is a VPN, and the most impressive VPNs (like the ones below) are simple to use. Just download the client app for your chosen device - our favorite VPNs have mobile versions for Android and iOS as well as PC and Mac ones - install it, and choose the country you want the VPN to show as your location. Then it’s just a matter of hitting the on switch or go button. That begins to re-route your internet traffic through the VPN’s own network, effectively disguising your location and actual IP address. No, no, no.A free VPN—whether it’s an app you download or a service you pay for and set up on your devices manually—is bad, because if a company isn’t charging you a penny for server investments or upkeep, it’s undoubtedly making its money by tracking everything you do and selling that information to someone else. Even well-known companies are guilty of this. Trust nobody that uses the f-word to try and entice you to use a VPN.I see sales for paid VPN services all the time, too, and I’m usually hesitant to pull the trigger on any of them. They aren’t free, so there’s that, but you still have make a decision based on trust. A service you’ve never heard of, headquartered in a foreign country, has a lovely looking privacy policy that claims it’s not tracking a single thing you’re doing. How can you be sure?I’ve scoured through advice from a number of legitimate security- and privacy-minded watchdogs, and here’s a roundup of the basic tips you’ll want to keep in mind when shopping for a VPN service. There are a lot of them, but they’re important because your data security is important.Federal Trade CommissionResearch the VPN app before you use it. You are trusting a VPN with potentially all of your traffic. Before you download a VPN app, learn as much about the app as you can. Look up outside reviews from sources you respect. You can also look at screenshots, the app’s description, its content rating, and user reviews, and can do some online research on the developer. The fact that an app promises security or privacy does not necessarily make it trustworthy.Carefully review the permissions the app requests. Apps will present the permissions they request on their app store page, during installation, or at the time they use the permission. It’s useful information that tells you what types of information the app will access on your device in addition to your internet traffic. If an app requests particularly sensitive permissions (reading text messages, for example), consider whether the permission makes sense given the app’s purpose and whether you trust the app developer with that access.Electronic Frontier FoundationHow long has your VPN provider been around? If it is relatively new and without a reliable history, you’d have to trust the provider a great deal in order to use such a service.Does the VPN provider log your traffic? If yes, what kind of information is logged? You should look for one that explicitly promises to not log your Internet traffic and how active the VPN provider is in advocating for user privacy.Does the VPN provider use encryption in providing the service? It’s generally recommended to use services that support a well-vetted open source protocol like OpenVPN or IPsec. Utilizing these protocols ensures best security available.If your VPN provider uses encryption, but has a single shared password for all of the users, it’s not sufficient encryption. While I have a handful of reviewers I trust for solid gadget and software recommendations, VPNs are a different story entirely. I’ve seen plenty of reviews that are just speed tests masquerading as helpful advice. How long it takes to download files, while useful, shouldn’t be the top priority when you’re picking your next VPN. Security and privacy are much more important, and not everyone tests these aspects as well as others (if at all).You’ll be the most secure if you set up and run your own VPN, but that’s likely beyond most people’s skills. It’s a little easier to use a VPN server that’s built into your router or network-attached storage, but that’s only useful if you’re looking to encrypt your traffic on a public wifi connection.
